Placer County Water Agency General Manager David A. Breninger on Thursday (Sept. 4) announced the appointment of Mal Toy as the water agency's Director of Planning Services.

Toy, who previously served as the Agency's Planning Administrator, has been with PCWA since 1995 and has played a key role in the agency's water resource planning strategies throughout Placer County.

In his new position, Toy will continue his active involvement in both eastern and western Placer County water availability planning and maintain a close working relationship with the Agency's many key stakeholders in Placer County and in the region on water resource issues. He serves as the Agency's representative in all watershed groups important to the various water resources flowing into, through, and out of Placer County's 1,500 square miles.

Toy, who resides in the greater Roseville area, has worked in planning and engineering for 30 years. He holds a master's degree in civil engineering from Loyola Marymount University. His wife, Cindy, works in the real estate business. His son, Andrew, is in the United States Air Force Reserve and is currently being trained as an intelligence analyst.
