*Auburn* – Placer County Water Agency District 1 Director Pauline Roccucci of Roseville has been appointed to a one-year term on the Policy Makers Council of the American Public Power Association (APPA).

The Washington, DC-based APPA Policy Makers Council is comprised of local elected and appointed officials representing public power communities across the nation. The council is a critical link between public power producers and policy makers in the nation's capital.

Roccucci, a former Roseville mayor and city council member and five-year elected member of the PCWA Board of Directors, was nominated for the APPA post by the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) and the Northern California Power Association (NCPA).

Roccucci has been active for 14 years with the NCPA and was Chair in 1995. She served 7 years on the APPA Board of Directors. She will represent the Southwest region—California, Arizona and Nevada—on the Policy Makers Council.

Roccucci will be attending the Policy Makers Council meeting and the APPA Legislative Rally Feb. 1-4 at the Renaissance Washington Hotel in Washington, DC.
