AUBURN -- A California Project WET (Water Education for Teachers) Workshop will be offered on Saturday, Sept. 25, in Auburn.

Sponsored by the Placer County Water Agency, the workshop will be held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Placer Nature Center at 3700 Christian Valley Road. Lunch is included.

Developed through the Sacramento-based Water Education Foundation, Project WET is designed to promote awareness, appreciation and knowledge of California's water resources.
