Auburn – The Board of Directors of the Placer County Water Agency on Thursday (July 21) approved an agreement with Nevada Irrigation District to use PCWA delivery point to delivery water to the City of Lincoln.

- Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the US Forest Service, California Department of Parks and Recreation, Placer County OES, Placer County Sheriff, and PCWA to establish a unified command post location for emergency incidents involving the Agency's Middle Fork Project Emergency Action Plan.

- Einar Maisch, Director of Strategic Affairs, apprised the Board of the Placer County Board of Supervisor's meeting regarding an advisory measure that was proposed to be placed on the November special election ballot regarding the use of groundwater in Placer County.

In other business, directors

- heard a presentation from Nolan Smith, District Archaeologist for the Tahoe National Forest, on the US Forest Service's 100th Birthday Celebration planned for August 20, 2005, at Robinsons Flat, Foresthill, CA. In a collaborative effort between PCWA, US Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, and the American River Ranger District the event will feature a full day of activities to commemorate the Forest Services 100th Anniversary, the official opening of the Robinsons Flat Campgrounds and Interpretive Guard Station.
