PCWA Sponsors Water Workshop for Teachers

AUBURN -- A California Project WET (Water Education for Teachers) Workshop will be offered for Placer County teachers on Saturday, Sept. 24, in Christian Valley near Auburn.

Sponsored by the Placer County Water Agency, the workshop will be held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Placer Nature Center at 3700 Christian Valley Road. Lunch is included.

Project WET is a program of the Sacramento-based Water Education Foundation, designed to promote awareness, appreciation and knowledge of California's water resources. The Water Education Foundation is a private, non-profit educational organization dedicated to educating California citizens on all aspects of California's most precious resource- water.

The workshops are especially useful for public and private school teachers in grades K-12 who wish to help educate future generations about the importance of our water supplies. All activities are correlated to the California content standards in science, history and language arts.

Each participating teacher will receive a copy of the Project WET curriculum and activity guide with over 90 activities, a water educator's conservation guide and an opportunity to receive a \$150 stipend.
