Auburn - Financial assistance grants to three community water suppliers were approved Thursday (May 17) by the Placer County Water Agency Board of Directors.

The 2007 grants include:

- \$15,000 to the Squaw Valley Public Service District for an alternative water supply feasibility study. The district plans to study the potential for importing water into Olympic Valley.

- \$10,000 to the Tahoe City Public Utility District for a water system hydraulic model update. The district will use the funding to analyze the possibility of providing water service to neighboring private water systems.

- \$10,000 to the Foresthill Public Utility District on the western slope for a water supply evaluation and modeling study to determine water supply yields for future decision making.

The three local projects were among six competing for a total \$35,000 available through the 2007 grant program. Since 1993, PCWA has granted more than \$1.2 million to local water purveyors in Placer County.
