AUBURN -- A water system upgrade in Auburn will require weekday road closures over a three-week period on Cherry Avenue between Boardman Street and Lincoln Way, the Placer County Water Agency announced this week (Aug. 30).

The work location will be closed to through traffic; however access will be available for residents and businesses.

Closure of Cherry Avenue is planned Mondays through Fridays from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm, beginning Tuesday (Sept. 4) and continuing to approximately Sept. 21. Agency officials are hopeful the road closure will have only minimal impacts to people in the area.

The road closure is necessary for the water agency to replace a 4-inch pipeline with a new 8-inch pipeline between Lincoln Way and Boardman Street.

"We appreciate our customers' patience and understanding," said PCWA Director of Field Services Mike Nichol. "This pipeline replacement will help improve long-term water service reliability to the area."
