### **Snowmobiling Access on Mosquito Ridge Road**

Placer County Water Agency, in compliance with requirements from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, is in the process of expanding the spillway at French Meadows Reservoir.

Snowmobiling on Mosquito Ridge Road this spring may be affected by the spillway project as PCWA's contractor removes snow in order to provide access to facilities. Snowmobile ramps will be installed at the intersection of Mosquito Ridge Road and Robinson Flat/Duncan Peak Road to allow snowmobiles to cross the road. Ramps will also be provided at the south end of the dam and also west of the dam on Forest Service Road #22.

Mosquito Ridge Road is gated near Interbay turn-off in order to permit the snow plows to complete their work. The road will remain gated until the U.S. Forest Service determines that conditions are safe for public use. Additionally, a slide on Mosquito Ridge Road near Milepost 18 restricts travel to one lane and is being actively monitored for movement.
